General Membership meeting Tuesday Sept. 28, 1982 in the Lutheran Church meeting rooms in the Bellamah office building - corner of Montano & Taylor Ranch Road. Starts at 7:00 p.m. Most of the meeting will be devoted to Community Sciences Corp., headed by Cliff Spirock. This is the planning firm engaged by Bellamah and others to present a new planning concept for the corner of Coors and Montano.
