The breakdown is 37 for a Montano bridge, 5 against a Montano bridge and 2 for a bridge at El Pueblo. At the July 6 Board of Directors meeting another 2 people voted for a Montano bridge and 6 people voted against the bridge. That totals only a small percentage of Taylor Ranch residents. 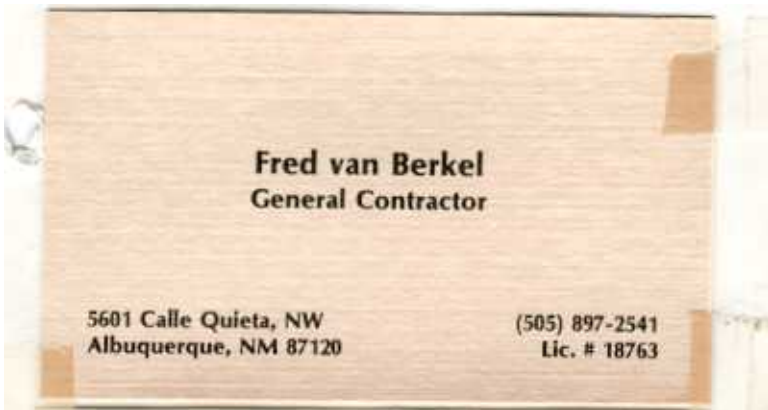

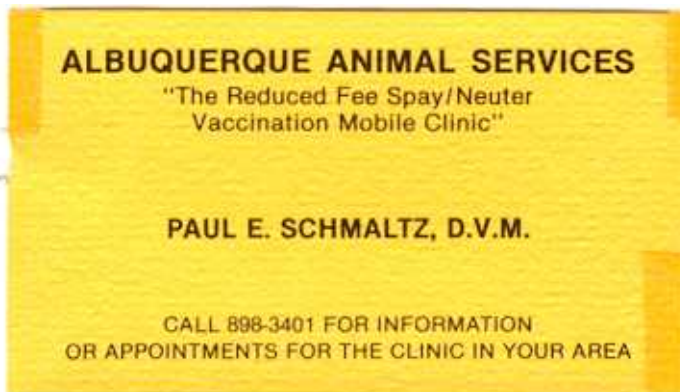
